## Directions to Show

- **From I-80 or Route 24:** Take I-287 South to exit 30B (Bernardsville). Turn left onto Route 202 South, proceed (3.3 miles) through town and make right onto Mt. Harmony Road. Continue 1.7 miles up to top of hill to the Church of St. John on the Mountain. Parking is on the left.
- **From I-78 E or W:** Take exit 33 (Bernardsville). Follow Route 525 North to light in Bernardsville center. Turn left onto Route 202 South and proceed through town to right on Mt. Harmony Road (1.5 miles). Proceed 1.7 miles to top of hill to the Church of St. John on the Mountain. Parking on the left.
- **From South:** Take I-287 North to exit 22. Follow Route 202 North for 4.8 miles to left on Mt. Harmony Road. Proceed 1.7 miles to top of hill to the Church of St. John on the Mountain. Parking is on the left.

## History

The Church of St. John on the Mountain's 30<sup>th</sup> Mountain Art Show continues as a premier local exhibition and sale of artwork by both regional and nationally recognized artists. The show attracts patrons from the prestigious Somerset Hills and beyond, who are rewarded with a large juried exhibition of artwork, as well as a selection of non-juried "small treasures." Proceeds from the Mountain Art Show each year directly benefit the church and its outreach programs.

## Judges for 2010

**Dr. Holly Pyne Connor**, Curator of Nineteenth-Century American Art at the Newark Museum since 2005, has organized numerous exhibitions including; *Small but Sublime: Intimate Views by Durand, Bierstadt and Inness* (2008); *Off the Pedestal: New Woman in the Art of Homer, Chase and Sargent* (2006); and *Picturing America* (2001). Dr. Connor, who previously was the Assistant Curator of Painting and Sculpture at the Brooklyn Museum, received a B.A. from Boston University, a M.A. from the Courtauld Institute, University of London, and a Ph.D. from Rutgers.

**Amze Emmons** received a BFA with a concentration in Painting and Printmaking from Ohio Wesleyan University and received his MFA in Print from the University of Iowa. His works have been exhibited at Aqua Miami, Scoula International di Graphica Venice, Works on Paper Gallery in Philadelphia, OH&T Gallery in Boston, Wendy Cooper Gallery in Chicago, The Cedar Rapids Museum of Art, Palace of Arts in Belarus, The International Print Center of New York, The Philadelphia Print Center, The Baltimore Museum of Art, The Fogg Museum at Harvard, and the Tama Art Museum in Tokyo.

**Sarah McKenzie** received her BA in Film Studies from Yale University, her MFA in Painting from the University of Michigan, and was a professor on the faculty of the Cleveland Institute of Art. McKenzie was the 2006 First-Place Winner of the National Young Painters Competition. Her paintings have appeared in *Art in America*, *New American Paintings*, *Dwell*, *Landscape Architecture*, *the Miami Herald*, and *the Denver Post*. She is represented in New York by Jen Bekman Gallery and in Denver by Robischon Gallery.

## Juried Show Eligibility

Only original artwork, not previously submitted in our show, is eligible in the following media:

Acrylics	Graphics	Mixed Media
Oils	Pastel	Photography
Watercolor	Sculpture	Hand-Editioned Prints*
Art Glass	Art Pottery	Fine Jewelry

\*e.g.: lithographs, silk-screens, etching, or stone-block

- No off-set or computer art.
- Artwork with metal frames larger than 36" square must be presented under plexi-glass.
- 3-D entries must include a display stand for exhibition.
- **All artwork must be priced with the true intention of selling.**
- **The Mountain Art Show will retain a 30% commission on all pieces sold.**
- Artwork for the Juried Show is limited to 3 entries.

## Juried Show Entry Procedures

All juried show entries must be received no later than August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Each accepted entry must be available for exhibition and sale during the show.

- Complete the enclosed Entry Form and return it with CD or slides as directed below and your check or money-order to cover non-refundable entry fees to:

- Limit 3 entries per artist. Fees: \$25.00 for one entry, \$30.00 for two, and \$35.00 for three entries.
- Submit entries on a CD or a 2"x 2" standard mounted 35-mm color slide for each entry. Please indicate artwork orientation.
- 3-D entries require 2 slides for each entry; frontal and side views.
- Label each CD or slide in block print with your name, the title of your work, the medium, and framed size of work. Indicate slide orientation on the blank side of your slide.

## Small Treasures and Portfolio Exhibit & Sale

The Mountain Art Show offers a non-juried exhibit to provide you and the patrons the opportunity to benefit from the sale of lower priced, original works; excluding 3-D works and crafts.

### Small Treasure Requirements:

- Entries must be framed and wired for hanging. Tab hangers are not acceptable.
- Size not to exceed 18"x 24". Price not to exceed \$300.
- Entry fee \$25.00; maximum of 8 pieces per artist.
- Bring/send framed pieces in a **boldly labeled box** with separators to protect your inventory. Any unsold artwork will be returned in these boxes on Pick-Up day

### Portfolio Requirements:

- Entries must be matted and un-framed.
- Hand-editioned original prints are accepted.
- Entry fee is \$25.00. Limit of 10 pieces per artist.
- Bring/send matted pieces in one black regulation sized (32" max.) portfolio. Stands will be provided.

## Small Treasure/Portfolio Entry Procedures

- Completely fill-out the enclosed Small Treasure /Portfolio Registration Form and Inventory List. Return them with your check or money order to cover non-refundable entry fees by October 1, 2010. See Juried Show Entry Procedures for mailing address.
- Bring Artist's copy of the Small Treasure/Portfolio Inventory sheet along with you on Receiving Day, or send with shipped works. No artwork will be accepted without inventory lists.
- Print your name, the title, and number from inventory list on the reverse side of each work; and **place the price on the front of each piece.**
- No small treasures or portfolio entries will be accepted on Receiving Day without prior registration. ST/P-only deadline is October 1, 2010.
